### WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT FROM US?

- a full assessment of your support needs and to be treated with courtesy and respect by staff at all times.
- appropriate and accessible information on treatment options available including shared care with your GP.
- regular one-to-one appointments with a Lifeline alcohol worker to discuss your treatment and care plan.
- specialist group work and relapse prevention.
- blood borne virus services including testing and vaccinations.
- support into training, education and employment.
- referrals for inpatient detox and residential rehabilitation.
- support for parents.
- treatment as part of a court order.

### WHAT DOES THE SERVICE EXPECT OF YOU?

- as far as possible to reduce or not drink alcohol prior to appointment.
- to attend appointments on time.
- to behave appropriately and treat all staff with courtesy and respect at all times.
