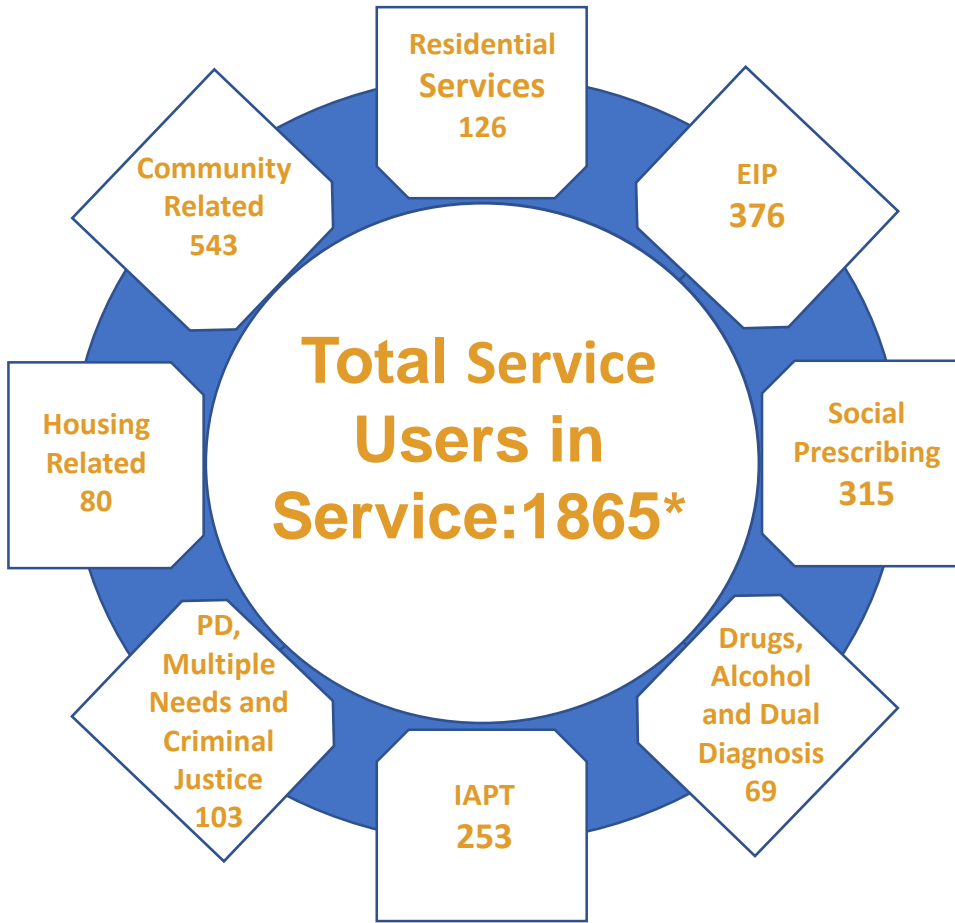


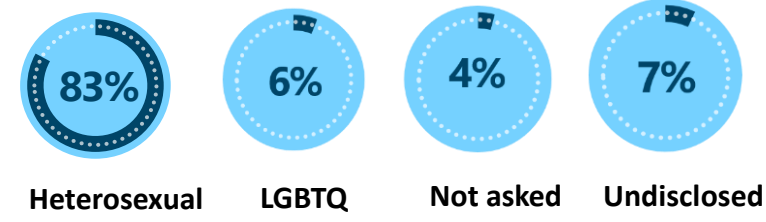

## Gender Breakdown of Service Users



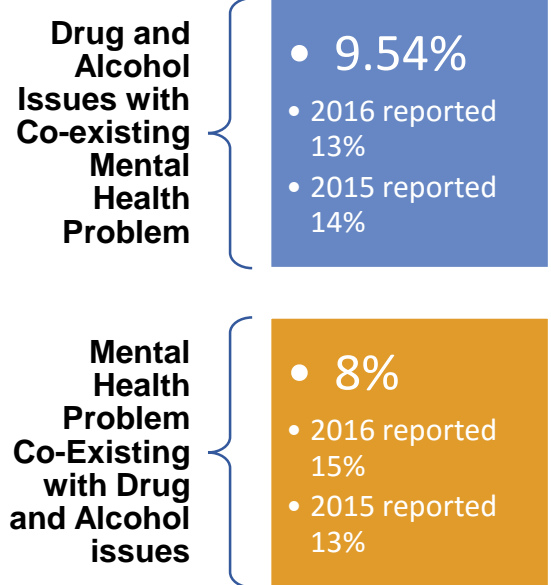
## Sexuality Breakdown of Service Users



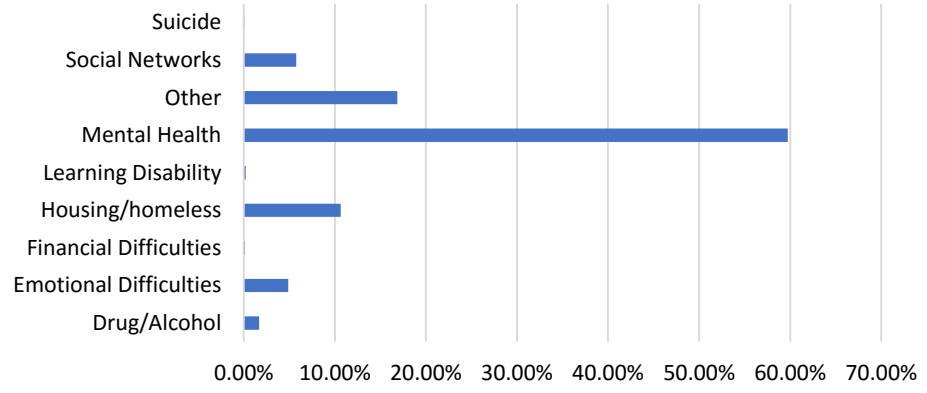
## Disability Breakdown of Service Users

8.10% of Service Users reported as having a disability. This is the second year running CL have seen a reduction in Service Users reporting a disability

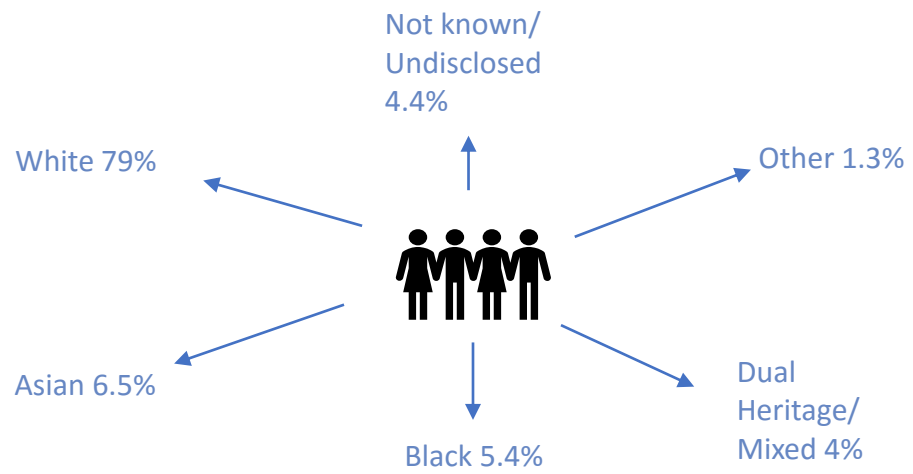
## Dual Diagnosis Breakdown of Service Users
